Re: Charity and Non-Uniform Days

As you will be aware, as a school we are very proud of our students and the way that they demonstrate the core values, in particular their responsibility and leadership qualities in terms of charity fundraising. It is to this end that we will continue to formalise the non-uniform days, thus allowing students to show their support for a range of causes in addition to their individual tutor group charities.

The non-uniform days will be on the following dates:

- **Friday 15th November 2019** – in support of Children In Need (national charity)
- **Tuesday 17th December 2019** – End of term (proceeds towards a local charity which will be determined by the School Council. We will notify you of the chosen charity nearer the time)
- **Friday 13th March 2020** - Comic Relief & British Red Cross (international charities)
- **Thursday 25th June 2020** – Wrong Trousers Day (local charity) Please note that students are still expected to wear school uniform on their top half for this day.
- **Friday 3rd July 2020** – End of term (proceeds towards dedicated House Charity)

Please note that non-uniform does still mean that clothes need to be suitable for school, for example no midriffs showing and the rules regarding hair and jewellery still apply.

I do appreciate that we ask students for a contribution to charity of £1 for each non-uniform day, and I would like to emphasise that there is absolutely no pressure for a student to participate (they are welcome to wear full school uniform as usual). However, recognition and support of these charities does reinforce our collective school approach to local, national and global awareness of others.
